- ENTER AT THE 'MAIN ENTRANCE' TO THE HOSPITAL
- PROCEED STRAIGHT AHEAD AND TAKE THE ELEVATOR DOWN TO THE 1ST FLOOR
- FOLLOW THE PURPLE LINE TO THE NEUROLOGY/STROKE CLINIC

- **BRING ALL MEDICATIONS and YOUR HEALTH CARD WITH YOU**

If you develop any acute symptoms of stroke, including the inability to speak, inability to walk, a weakness or numbness in half the body, or severe headache, please call 911 to be taken to Niagara Falls Site ED, where the Acute Stroke Centre is located.

If you have any questions please speak with the emergency department physician or nurse before you leave.

Your family doctor is the best way to access medical care and acts as the central person in your overall healthcare. If you do not have a family doctor, we strongly advise you to get one.
